What's involved?

The Events Promotion Officer will work with the Learning Officer and Learning Team and the Marketing Team. Tasks include:

- Becoming familiar with all aspects of the learning programme
- Producing and scheduling posts for the Museum's social media pages Facebook,
 Twitter and Instagram
- Promoting activities and events on established listing platforms and advising on additional ones
- Distributing leaflets, posters and other publicity materials to libraries, community centres and other relevant locations to help promote the museum and programme

What skills and experience do you need?

You should:

- Understand the use of social media and their various audiences
- Have excellent writing skills

- Be computer-literate
- Be well organised, reliable, self-motivated and able to keep to deadlines
- Friendly outgoing and with good people skills
- Committed to equality and diversity

What's in it for you?

You will be able to use your skills and experience, perhaps in a different field from your previous work. You will be helping to contribute to the success of the Heath Robinson Museum. We are a friendly, active volunteer team and there is plenty of opportunity to meet people and be involved in events.
