The makers change every six months, - this is now our sixth group - adding more valuable creative partnerships and creating a distinctive decorative art marketplace at the Heath Robinson Museum

Sylvia Colley, first inspired by her daughter Victoria, started to study jewellery making at Missenden Abbey. She is showing an eclectic range in silver, some featuring gold, brass, semi-precious or precious stones. Her work encompasses both delicate and bold designs. All work is hallmarked and she attends weekly sessions at a professional jewellery workshop. Sylvia is also one of our museum volunteers and a published author and poet.
